Apresentação

Esta Bibliografia Geral Consolidada reúne as referências acadêmicas presentes nas bibliografias comentadas dos 14 volumes de História Comparada - Impérios. A extração identificou 1259 entradas bibliográficas de origem. Depois da harmonização de grafia e da deduplicação por autoria e título, o conjunto resultou em 1096 referências consolidadas, com indicação dos volumes em que cada obra aparece.

O objetivo é oferecer um ponto único de consulta para a coleção. Comentários explicativos próprios de cada volume foram retirados desta versão para evitar repetição; permanecem autor, título e os dados editoriais disponíveis na referência mais completa encontrada na coleção. Quando uma obra aparece em mais de uma edição, prevalece a forma bibliográfica mais informativa, sem apagar os volumes em que outras edições foram citadas.

A bibliografia acadêmica foi mantida separada dos acervos, cursos, bases de dados, museus e fontes digitais listados ao final de cada volume. Esses recursos formam outro universo documental e poderão ser consolidados em um guia próprio.

Critérios de consolidação

- Uma obra repetida em vários volumes aparece uma única vez, seguida da marcação [Vn] ou [Vn, Vm ...].
- Títulos abreviados foram associados a formas mais completas quando autoria e título-base coincidiam de maneira inequívoca.
- Capítulos, artigos e ensaios permanecem separados dos livros ou coletâneas em que foram publicados; citar a mesma obra coletiva não transforma textos diferentes numa única referência.
- Dados editoriais ausentes no volume de origem não foram inventados. Quando não existia outra ocorrência mais completa na coleção, a referência permanece abreviada.
- A ordenação principal é alfabética pelo primeiro autor ou editor. A marcação de volumes permite reconstruir o uso historiográfico dentro da coleção.

Panorama quantitativo

O corpus bibliográfico reúne 1259 entradas originárias e 1096 referências consolidadas. O processo removeu 163 repetições ou formas abreviadas de obras já representadas por uma referência mais completa. 25 obras aparecem em três ou mais volumes.
